Bill Gates: The wealthiest man in the world who has been said to quote that; "I failed in some subjects in exam, but my friend passed in all. Now he is an engineer in Microsoft and I am the owner of

Microsoft”. If passing exams in school made us millionaires, this guy who Bill Gates quoted about would have be a billionaire today; now it doesn’t work like that.

Les Brown: Labeled mentally retard in school, and no college certificates, but today is the world most successful, highest paid motivational speaker and author, ready his book “Live Your Dreams”.

Jack Ma: "I failed 3 times in college. I applied 30 times to get a job but I was always rejected. When KFC came to China for the first time, we were 24 to apply and I was the only one dismissed. I wanted to go into the police but I was the only one not accepted. I applied 10 times to Harvard University in the US and I was rejected. "Jack Ma, Alibaba Creator and 22nd Worlds richest man according to fortune and according to Forbes 2015 list with \$29.8 billion net-worth. Moral of the story: Failure is the step stone for success.

Bob Proctor: No college or university qualification, today he is the co-founder of the world’s leading finance and personal development company in the world “Proctor Gallagher Institute”, world highest paid success speaker and world bestselling author of ‘You were born rich’, ‘The Art of Living’ and many of his great books.

Parents who produced these kids above are the ones who deserve to be 100% called great parents, not parents who believe in the school-system that produce slave kids to society to become employees to work for the people who have never even been to school, never even finished school. Chapter 3

Your Car

A car takes away money from you through buying fuel (gas), buying spare parts, road taxes, driving license taxes, and even become worse if you find yourself in an accident.

Your Job

Your Pension

"The biggest corporations, from banks and pharmaceutical companies to farm conglomerates and oil companies, have the power to influence laws, all in the name of helping the people. The 401(k) and IRA retirement programs in the United States are examples of 'legalized plunder'. This is why there is no financial education in the school-system.

7. It is part of big corporation business plan to keep people financially ignorant through the school system. This is exactly what the big banks and financial services industries want. Your financial ignorance is part of their grand financial plan and business. And among the objectives of the financial industry is to keep the people confused.

Chapter 6

Chapter 7

A great teacher is a gifted teacher, is a doctor who heals ignorance and an artist who inspires and motivates creativity within students.

Chapter 8

The Difference Between School and Education

Many of us think school and education is the same. Let's get to the roots first; the meaning of school from the Greek root means 'Skolia'. From the Scottish root means 'Loch'. From the German root means 'Doch'.

Then what is the Greek word school 'skolia' mean? Skolia means 'free time', since Greeks thought that it was the time for learning. School 'Skolia' from the Greek means 'Leisure, philosophy, or place where lectures are given'. The Greeks had mastery schools, which I call Ancient-schools, and mastery schools were there to help people discover their potentials within, to know thyself and understand how their minds worked, but not the industrial age school philosophy of mass producing slaves to work for a few rich people and pay more taxes to the government.

Gurdjieff put it clear that "The first reason for man's inner slavery is his ignorance, and above all, his ignorance of himself. Without self-knowledge, without understanding the workings and function of his machine, man cannot be free, he cannot govern himself, and he will always remain a slave, the playing of forces acting upon him. This why in an ancient teaching the first demand at the beginning of the way to liberation was to 'Know Thyself'".

Industrial Age School Philosophy

The industrial age school philosophy was designed to produce more workers to work in factories like the Henry Ford factories, the Andrew Carnegie factories, the John D. Rockefeller factories, etc. The

purpose behind school was to train more students in school so that they go to work in the factories for rich people of that moment.

The problem is that today we are no longer in the 20th century industrial age where employees used to sell their labor for money. We are in the 21st century where people are using technology to do their work for them. In the 21st century employers don't need a lot of employees because machines or robots are doing most of the human labor that humans used to work for money in the 20th century.

Today robotic labor is replacing human labor, and that's why we are having fewer and fewer jobs on the market, and this is what is causing the high rise of this global unemployment. But we are still using the old obsolete school philosophy of the industrial age way of training and advising even to date to our kids,

unemployed students with school papers that are making our streets dirty with certificates that are becoming waste papers. That's why "Much education today is monumentally ineffective. All too often we are giving young people cut flowers when we should be teaching them to grow their own plants" said, John W. Gardner. Remember that old ways won't open new doors. Your change is needed.
